

BIDEN, CARPER, CASTLE SUPPORT IRS "SUPER SATURDAY" -- MARCH 28, 2008

Wilmington and Dover, DE -- On Saturday, March 29, 2008, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) will host "Super Saturday" at 320 IRS offices across the country. As part of the Economic Stimulus Act of 2008, some Delawareans who would not normally file a tax return may be eligible for the minimum payment. The purpose of this Saturday's event is to help retirees, veterans, and low-income workers file for and receive their Economic stimulus payments. Both of Delaware's IRS offices in Wilmington and Dover will be open to aid Delawareans through the stimulus payment process.

"There are approximately 60,000 Delawareans who will qualify to receive an economic stimulus payment that may not normally be required to file a tax return because their income falls below the normal filing requirement," the delegation said. "'Super Saturday' is a great way for Delawareans who fall into that category to learn how they too can receive their economic stimulus payments."

To be eligible for the minimum economic stimulus payment of \$300, people must have at least \$3,000 of qualifying income (including wages, nontaxable combat pay and certain benefits from Social Security, Veterans Affairs and Railroad Retirement).
