

CONGRESS, CASTLE HONORS MEALS ON WHEELS -- April 14, 2008

Washington, DC - Today, Rep. Michael N. Castle (R-DE), supported House passage of H.RES. 259, a resolution recognizing the valuable work of the Meals On Wheels Association of America.
