

## IRS: 18,000 in Del. haven't claimed rebate checks (The News Journal)

DOVER - The Internal Revenue Service says an estimated 18,000 people in Delaware have not claimed their fiscal stimulus rebate checks.

Agency spokesman Gregg Semanick says about 58,000 disabled veterans and retirees normally don't file tax returns but were eligible for the checks. As of mid-June, he says only 40,000 filed to get the checks.

The receive the \$300 and \$600 checks, those eligible must file a tax return.

Congressman Michael Castle has been holding workshops throughout the state to raise awareness about how residents can claim their checks. He will hold a workshop at 12:30 p.m. at the CHEER Community Center in Georgetown.

Semanick says the IRS is sending a second mailing to those who haven't filed a tax return but could be eligible for a stimulus check.
