At the present time, Rep. Castle's office has already received far more requests than can be matched with allotted tickets; therefore, no more requests will be taken.

Rep. Castle is encouraging Delawareans wishing to attend the inauguration to simply attend in the non-ticketed viewing areas along the parade route and on the National Mall, where the public can see the ceremony via a large video screen.

It is important to note that tickets advertised or being sold on the Internet for the ceremony are not valid. There have been reports of high-priced scams on multiple websites, and it should be noted that to sell these tickets is illegal.
