

Castle Questions Big Auto Executives (WILM)

U.S. auto executives were appearing before the House Financial Services Committee for the second time Friday to outline their plans for staying afloat with a government infusion. Congressman Castle says the rise in the nation's unemployment rate is causing many house leaders to rally support for a rescue plan. "Everyone is concerned about the suppliers, the automobile dealerships, they have much employment too, in fact, they have more employment than directly in the auto manufacturing." Castle thinks the House will defer to the Senate on a solution, but he believes something, along the lines of a "piece mail" package, will be passed within a couple of weeks.
